Why join? We do a lot with your dues to include:

- Cell phone service – not long ago, we could not use cell phones inside our homes. Thanks to your Village West Pool Board and a bit part by your CAWSV – we got the tower now at the pool.
- Traffic Light at Barnack & Rolling Road – your CAWSV representative along with the RVES PTA President (Deb Staron) drove to Richmond to meet with the VA Transportation Secretary to lobby for that traffic light. Thanks also to VDOT Engineer Jan Vaughan who waived the warrant requirements, approved the light, and found the money to put it in.
- Represent our majority opinion at hearings on the Rolling Road Widening Project concerning speed limit, storm water management and relocation of utility lines (ongoing issue through 2026).
- Provide a professionally managed website (www.westspringfieldvillage.org). Check it out!
- Manage a secure Facebook Group where you can get the word out quickly about a lost pet, missing child, or a new cake recipe. Email me or our Moderator, Wendi Dorey at thedorey4@gmail.com for instructions to join.
- Distribute weekly news via email on issues that impact community life.
- Host at no additional cost an annual community yard sale and community cleanup. The cleanup is free to members and a great way to get rid of that old grill, lawn mower, appliances, furniture and even sheds. County's support is on hold due to the pandemic; we will do one ourselves next month. Update4s will be provided by weekly enews.

- Host or co-host with Village West Pool several social and community events. Most are free regardless of your membership status in the CAWSV or the VW Pool.
- Contract to maintain Rolling Road median and the area around our village sign. When you can see oncoming traffic while attempting a left turn onto Rolling Road, thank your CAWSV and those who pay their annual dues.
- Publish a Community Directory chock full of good information and listings.

Dues are a modest \$10.00 per household for the fiscal year (10/1 – 9/30/following year). I can't think of any reason why you would not want to be a member; can you?
